HOUSING for Those Experiencing Homelessness – Arcata

HOUSING Arcata House Partnership and Danco Communities are renovating two projects in Valley West before they can be rented to qualified individuals experiencing homelessness. Both are primarily financed by “Homekey,” which is a program designed to assist developers in creating quality housing with supportive services for homeless people. Housing is expected to be available in December, 2022.

RENT The amount you pay in rent may be partially or fully subsidized depending on your income.

QUALIFICATION These are qualifications for renting the housing units:

- You must be currently homeless
- You must have income that is at or below a certain level (30% of the Area Median Income)
 - \$16,350 for an individual
 - \$18,700 for a 2-person family

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO To prepare for applying for housing you will need to be part of what is called the “Coordinated Entry System.” You may contact either of the following organizations to learn more about being entered into the system:
