



# Eureka Recycling Center at HWMA is Temporarily Closing

The Eureka Recycling Center will close August 1, 2022 and will re-open at a new location early 2023 pending property acquisition and permitting. The Transfer Station side of the facility – which accepts garbage – will continue to accept the recyclable materials below with a **green** checkmark.

This closure will allow HWMA and Humboldt County Jurisdictions, including the City of Arcata, to work toward SB 1383 compliance by utilizing this vacated space to conduct organics collection and processing activities. This means that organics recycling is coming to Humboldt!

## What is SB1383?

SB1383 is a new California Law, considered the largest change to waste management in thirty years, which affects *everyone*. It includes organics recycling and edible food recovery. All businesses and residents will need to subscribe to an organics collection service (when available).

Food-related businesses will be required to donate all excess edible food.
