

The Old Arcata Road Design Project's Community Open House took place on October 19th at the Bayside Grange. The Open House was attended by more than 55 neighborhood residents, parents of youth who attend local schools, and other individuals who regularly travel on Old Arcata Road between Buttermilk Lane and Jacoby Creek Road. The Open House showcased draft alternatives for the roadway that were developed based on community feedback at the kick-off meeting, walk audit and submitted to the City and project team as comments or letters throughout the past month and a half. The Open House was primarily focused on asking attendees what they liked, disliked, or would change about a number of alternatives. The project team also gave an overview presentation laying out the project purpose, explaining the alternatives in greater depth, and clarifying the next steps.
